

AUDITIONS FOR THE 2018-2019 HIGH SCHOOL CHOIRS

Please review carefully.

Choir members who ARE enrolled in a choir class this semester
will audition during class during the week of April 23-27.

Anyone who is not enrolled in a choir class this semester
will need to come to one of the after school audition dates - April 26 in the high school choir room OR May 1 in the middle school choir room. If there is a conflict with both of these dates, email Beck @ hlhschorus@yahoo.com

After reviewing scores from the auditions, reviewing audition forms, reviewing grades, & reviewing discipline, invitations for a second audition will be delivered along with materials for the second audition.

Preliminary Auditions

The student will:

- sing vocal exercises that are lead by the director
- sing "Happy Birthday" or "My Country tis Of Thee"
- sing a sight singing exercise - student chooses the difficulty level
- have a brief interview with the director

Second Audition *(by invitation only)*

The student will:

- sing a sight singing exercise
- have a rehearsal on the prepared piece (handed out with the second audition invitation)
- perform prepared piece in small groups

Choir letters will be mailed at the end of the school year. These letters will notify students if they have been placed in a choir. If placed, also enclosed will be important items like a calendar and payment dates.

THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND TURNED IN AT THE DESIGNATED AUDITION TIME. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

By completing the form below, you are stating that you have read the choir description pamphlet as well as the information on the front of this audition form. You understand that there are expenses for each choir (estimated \$50-\$100 depending on the choir) and specific outfit needs. All choirs include a weekly mandatory rehearsal after school on Wednesdays during the school year. Although the trip to New York is not mandatory, the smaller trip/day trip is mandatory for the members of the elite ensemble and strongly encouraged for the members of the mens choir & advanced women choir.

If selected to be a part of the choral department at Horn Lake High, you will receive a choir handbook in August that will contain many important details including expectations, guidelines, and forms.
