

- → black, closed toe dress shoes like ballerina flats



Ensemble *

\$500.00 = Ensemble members will have a total of 4 payment due dates since their total includes the spring tour cost. Their total can be paid at once by September 13, or it can be divided up (\$125.00) among the four due dates on the calendar - September 13, November 29, February 15, & balance by April 1. It would be preferred for all balances to be paid in full by the February 15 date if possible since the last date is so close to the tour dates.

* ALL CHOIR MEMBERS WILL BE GIVEN A TUNING FORK DURING THEIR FIRST SEMESTER OF CHOIR AT THE HIGH SCHOOL. IF LOST, A NEW ONE CAN BE PURCHASED THROUGH THE CHORAL DEPARTMENT AND \$10.00.

- * ALL CHOIR MEMBERS WILL BE GIVEN A BRAND NEW CHOIR FOLDER DURING THEIR FIRST SEMESTER IN CHOIR. HOWEVER, FOLDERS THAT NEED TO BE REPLACED DUE TO LOSS OR DAMAGE WILL COST THE CHOIR MEMBER \$19.00.
- * All choir members are expected to participate in fundraisers. A choir MEMBER WILL NEED TO COLLECT MONETARY DONATIONS TO COVER CHOIR EXPENSES IF HE/SHE CHOOSES NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN FUNDRAISERS.

YOUR STUFF

Piano: The piano is an instrument, not a piece of furniture. Never place anything on the piano at any time, nor should the piano be used as a writing surface at any time.

Belongings: Your belongings should be kept along the mirrored wall. Your belongings SHOULD NOT be on the desk, table, piano, risers, or shelves!

CASH APP Is

available through the choir boosters. If a deposit is made via CASH APP, follow the steps about turning in money, but use a CASH APP slip so that your payment is on record with the Choir Booster deposit system.

How to Turn In Money

ALL MONEY WILL BE TURNED IN THE SAME WAY. This would include fundraising, expenses, honor choir registration & lodging, letterman jackets, spirit gear, performance attire (girls), the choir trips, & 'fair share' (if applicable). The procedure for turning in money for choir members is listed below & is posted on the wall above the deposit box.

- find your deposit envelope in the basket & complete the front with the deposit information (date, amount, & what the money is for)
- complete the information on the deposit log clipboard
- have a director verify & sign BOTH the log & the envelope
- DO NOT SEAL THE ENVELOPE
- drop the envelope in the deposit box & return the log.

You will receive a receipt for all deposits! It is very wise to keep your receipts

on file at home! Some receipts will be from the Choir Boosters, others will be from

Horn Lake High School. This is because both accounts are used - certain trip/travel costs must run through the school, while other activities/needs are covered from the choir booster account.

- It is crucial that all money is paid on time. Choir members who are not current on their account payments will sit out of performances & other activities until their account is current!
- Meticulous records are kept of the HL Choir Accounts (booster & school). You are welcome to visit the choir room to see how the system works for yourself!

WE WILL BE USING DRAGONFLY AGAIN THIS YEAR. THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION REQUIRES ELIGIBILITY TO BE COMPLETED ELECTRONICALLY BY A PARENT/ GUARDIAN. IF A STUDENT IS INVOLVED IN A SPORT OR BAND, YOU DO NOT NEED TO COMPLETE THE PROCESS AGAIN. THE PROCESS IS SIMPLE - FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS THAT ARE HANDED OUT WITH THE CHOIR CONTRACTS AND MEDICAL FORMS. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO COMPLETE THE (1) ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE AGREEMENT, (2) MHSAA STUDENT PARTICIPATION CLEARANCE FORM, & (3) CONSENT TO THE DISCLOSURE AND USE OF PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION. THERE ARE STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE IN THE CHOR ROOM IF NEEDED, BUT HEALTH INSURANCE IS NOT REQUIRED FOR CHOIR MEMBERS

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Bluff City Choral Festival

This event is easily the favorite event of the year for the singers. This competition, that combines Team Building & Community Service along with Choral Performance, is a one day event held on the Senatobia campus of NWCC. This year's competition will be Saturday, April 6th. Detailed information will be sent home & posted on the choir website closer to time.



All singers will participate in one of these amazing one-day events sponsored by the University of Mississippi. All tenors & basses will participate on Saturday, September 23 while the Treble voices will participate on Saturday, March 23. Each event will be on the Ole Miss campus and will end with a concert at the end of the day that is open to the public. Detailed information will be sent home & posted on the choir website closer to time.

Riverland Choral Festival

All singers will participate in this one day event in Pearl on Saturday, November 4th. We will travel by charter bus to/from the competition. The competition cost covers the festival registration & charter bus cost. The competition is open to the public, but like most festivals, younger children are not permitted in the performance areas. Detailed information will be sent home & posted on the choir website closer to time.

London, England!

This year's North Mississippi Youth Chorale is comprised of singers primarily from DCHS & HLHS. NMYC will be traveling to London in March to perform in concert as part of a 300+ mass choir featuring the British superstar group, *Voces 8* (the *Pentatonix* of the UK). The concert includes a World Premier of a brand new work.

Although the deadline for registration & deposit have passed, there is a waiting list available for those interested in traveling if a spot becomes available! Select members will be invited to participate in a performance tour of Tennessee that will include stops in Jackson, Nashville, Knoxville, Gatlinburg/Pigeon Forge, & Cleveland/Chattanooga. We will be performing at local churches & participating in choir swaps at local schools including some colleges (Union, Belmont, Lipscomb & Lee University). We will also be competing at a Music in the Parks festival & spending some time at Dollywood! The cost of the trip is \$350.00 **
